Planning Act 2008: Consultation on list of statutory consultees for National Policy Statements

The UKACCs Liaison Group has asked that I should write to let you know their reactions to the consultation launched by your Department on 27th January last seeking views on who should be statutory consultees before a document is designated as a *National Policy Statement (NPS)* under the *Planning Act 2008*.


The Liaison Group believes individual Airport Consultative Committees should be included in the formal list of those bodies and organisations to be consulted in any subsequent guidance to be issued by the Department setting out the detailed procedures to be followed in the preparation of any NPS which has a bearing on airports or aviation. This applies in particular to the overall NPS on Aviation to be prepared by the Department of Transport but also to any other NPS which applies to airports or aviation generally. Individual local committees should be consulted about any NPS which might apply to the particular airport with which the Committee deals.
